## Job description

Every winter many senior households call Cudahy-St. Francis Interfaith for help with snow removal. Many seniors are physically unable to do this themselves and have no one to help. If they do not clear snow from the public sidewalk within 24 hours after a snowfall, the city will charge them a large fee, which they simply can't afford. Therefore some will risk injury to try to do it themselves. We are here to help.

- Shovelers are only paid by Interfaith to clear public sidewalk and 1 private path from door to sidewalk
- Only paid to clear 4" snow or more
- If senior wishes to have extra shoveling (under 4", driveways, or additional pathways) this is negotiated by and paid by senior
- Senior and shoveler will be given each other's phone numbers
- Shoveler will be given senior's name, address and phone number
- It is not necessary to call senior before shoveling but it is advisable to notify senior of hour/s after completion
- Shovelers may be partnered (i.e. 2 shovelers to 1 senior) if they cannot fulfill the commitment on their own
- It is the responsibility of the paired shovelers to schedule and communicate amongst themselves
- If there are any disputes over hours or expectations please contact the Interfaith office

## Job requirements:

- Accepting ages 14 and up
- Ages 14-17 need parental permission signature
- Ages 18 and over require a background check
- All paid \$7.25 per hour

- Time sheets must be kept **only** for time clearing public sidewalk and 1 path from door to sidewalk
- Time sheets must be signed by the senior
- Time sheets must be submitted to Interfaith
- Time sheets may only be submitted once 5 to 10 hours have accrued
- Shovelers must find out if they need to bring their own shovels or if the senior will provide
- Youth ages 14-17 are not allowed to use power equipment such as snow blowers under any circumstances
- Commitment is for every snowfall 4" or more, no matter the day, date, time or month
- Shoveler must be physically able to clear snow
- Anytime snowfall is over 4" shoveler must clear public sidewalk and 1 private walk from door to sidewalk within 24 hours after snow ends
- If shoveler if unavailable to clear snow they must arrange a substitute
- Substitutes **must** have a separate time sheet
